Some of the work shop projects were hay racks, wagon boxes, feed bunks, picnic tables and chairs, hog brooders, trailers, motor overhauling and machinery repair. Each boy that studies agriculture is required to complete at least one livestock or grain project. This gives the individual real experience in farming.

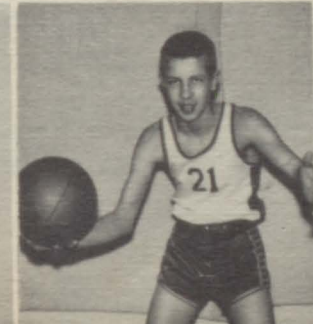
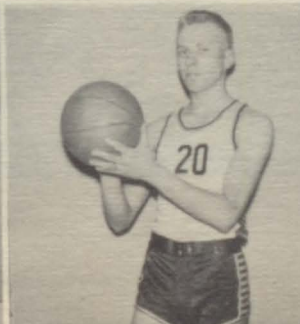
The Cubs placed 2nd in the District 19 tourney by being defeated by Lennox in the finals.

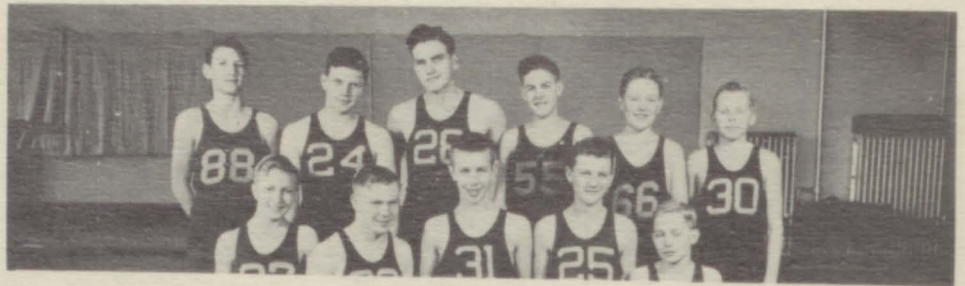

The Alcester football squad had a good season for the year 1949. Four victories, two losses and one tie was marked down in the records.

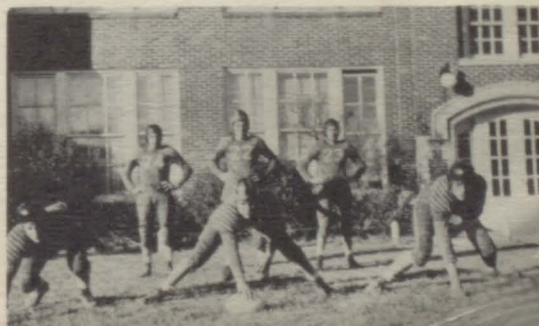
