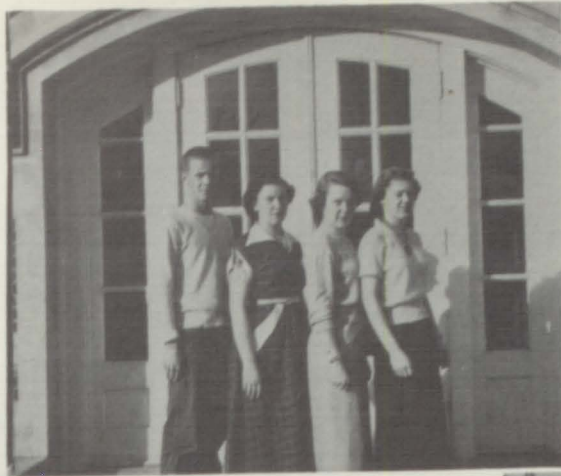
## OFFICE SECRETARY
