The dance followed coronation with music by KG95.

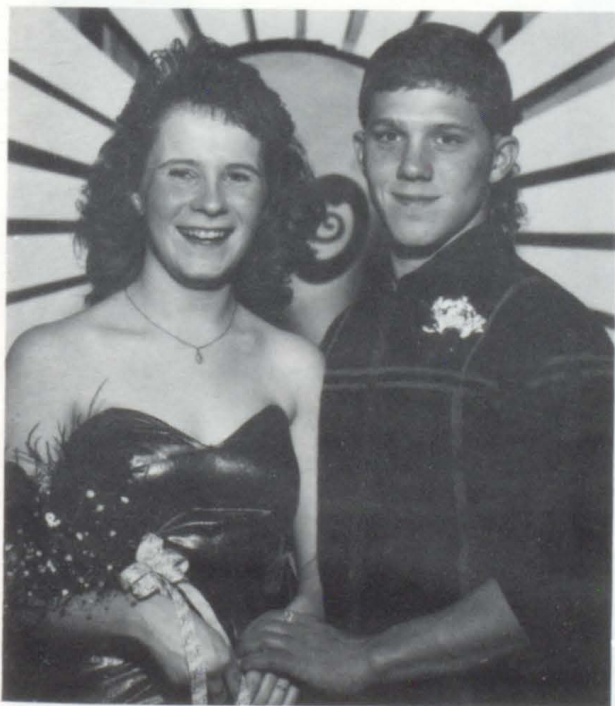

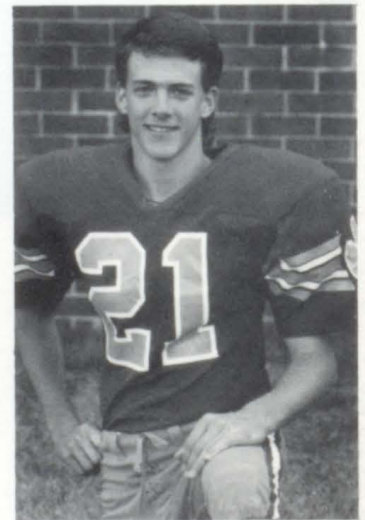

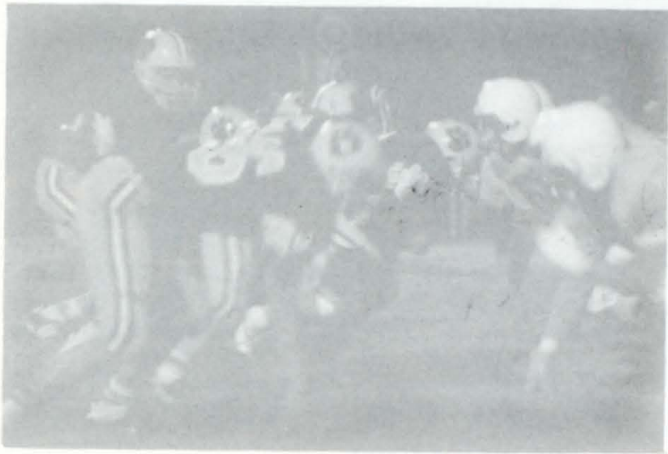

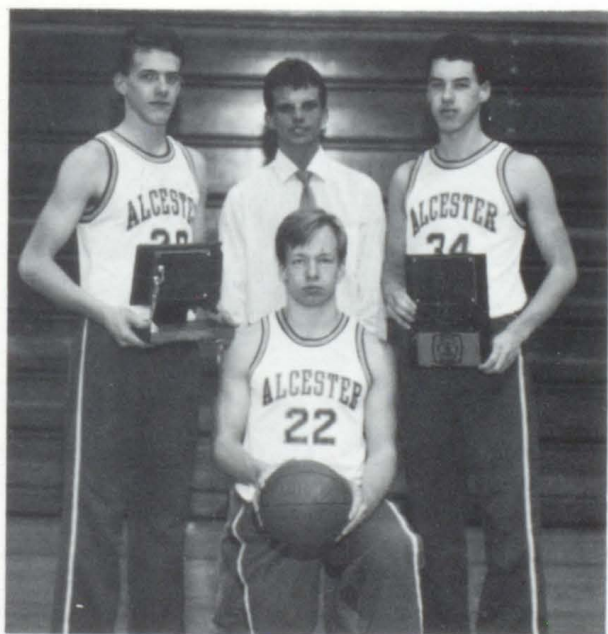

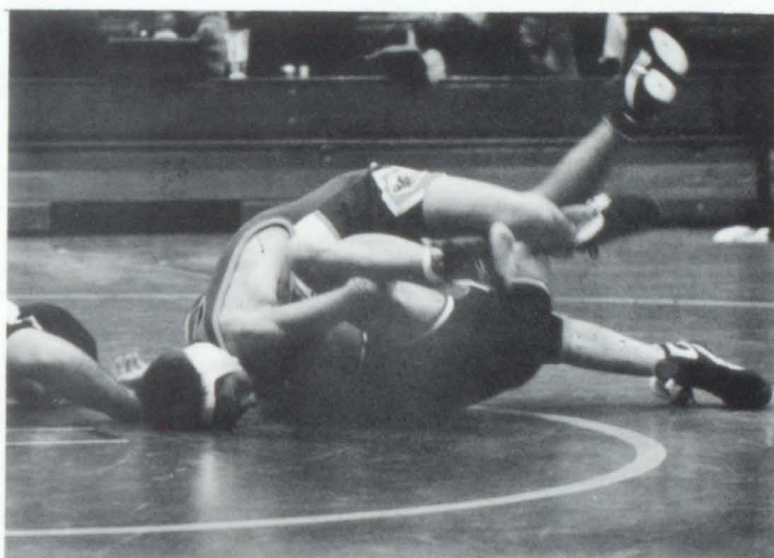
