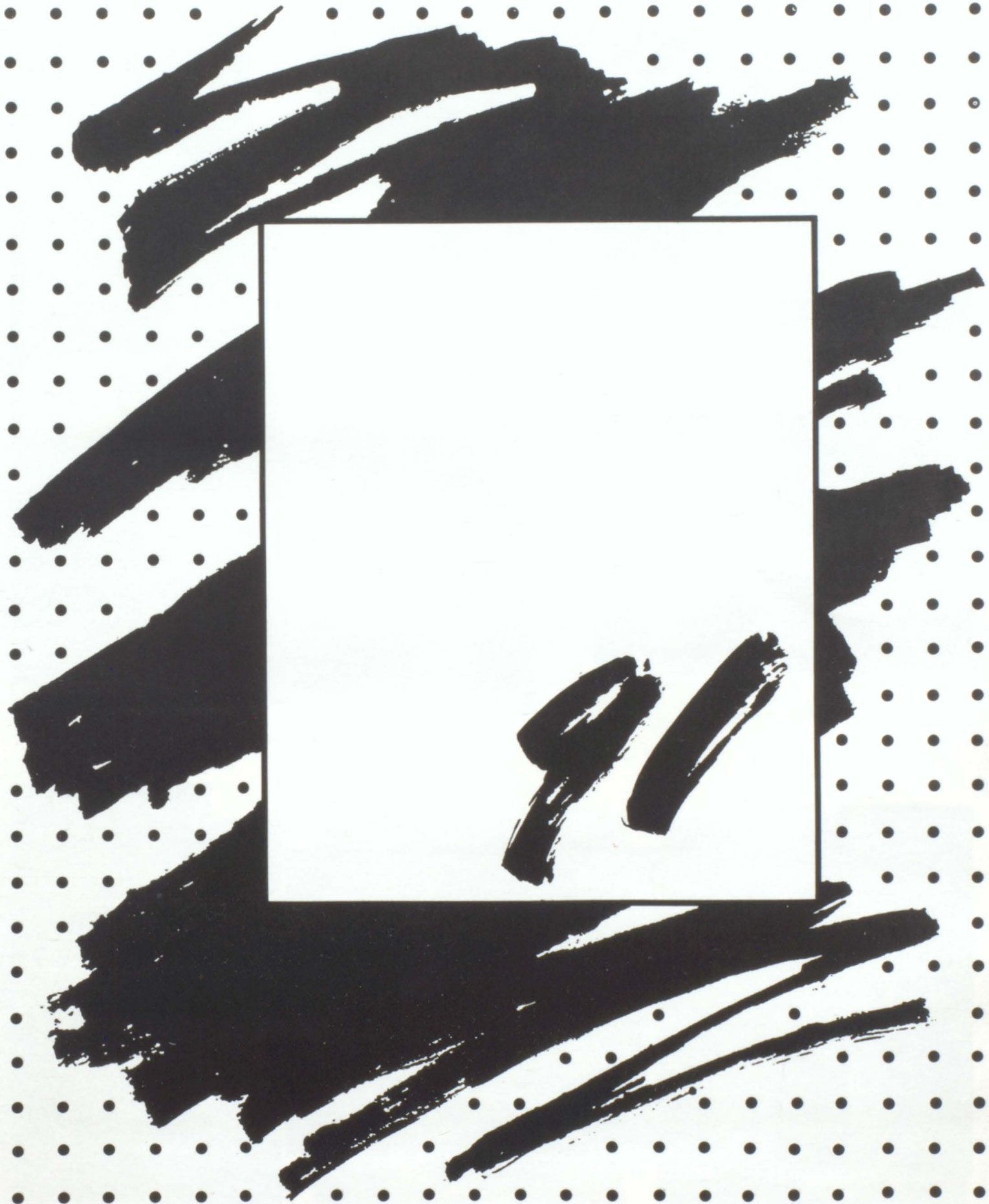
PROM 91

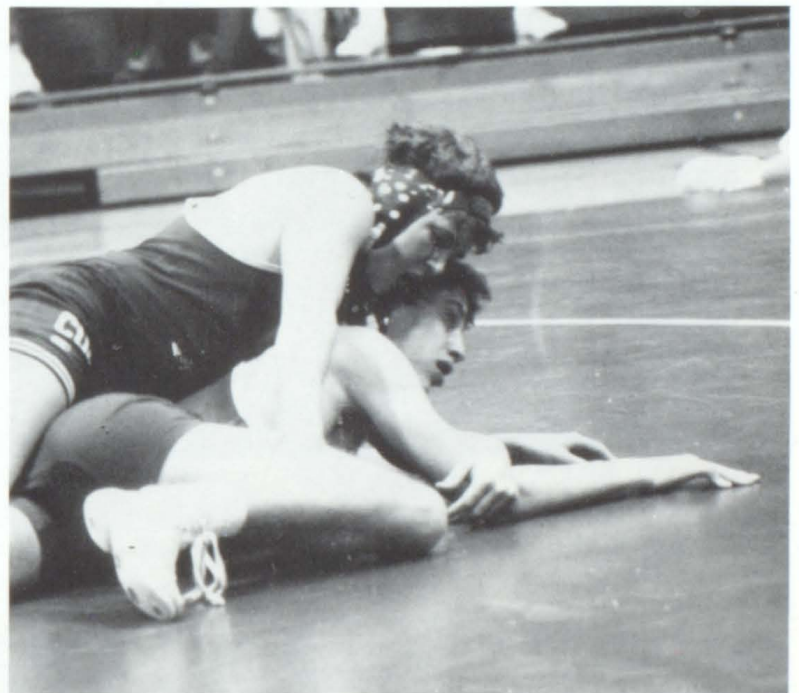
