## Alcester-Hudson Bus Rider Policy

## Rules/Disciplines

- 1. Students must respect/obey drivers at all times. Riding the bus is an extension of the school day. Students shall adhere to the same behavior expectations, standards, and consequences as at school.
- 2. No standing or moving around on bus when in motion.
- 3. Must remain sitting in seat after boarding until departure. No lying down or sitting on things such as books, duffle bags, or on knees.
- 4. When windows are open students are not allowed to have anything hanging out of the windows.
- 5. Students must keep aisles clear of any item or body extremities.
- 6. No eating or drinking allowed on the bus unless prior arrangements have been made with drivers, school and parents.
- 7. Students will be picked up and dropped off as designated stop unless prior arrangements have been made with parents.
- 8. No extra riders without written authorization or prior approval.
- 9. No throwing of items on bus or damage to bus will be tolerated. Any damages to busses will be repaired at the cost of the violator.
- 10. No fighting, horseplay or swearing will be allowed- Zero Tolerancea. Could immediately lead to discipline #3 listed below
- 11. Any destruction of property on the bus is subject to immediate removal until restitution is made or authorized by Alcester-Hudson School District.

Failure in following the rules above could lead to the following disciplines.

- 1<sup>st</sup> written warning-send home by mail to parents, followed by phone call
- 2<sup>nd</sup> written warning will lead to bus privileges being suspended for 1 week
- 3<sup>rd</sup> written warning will lead to no bus privileges for 2 weeks or TBD
- School administrators reserve the right to suspend bus privileges for longer than 2 weeks when warranted.
